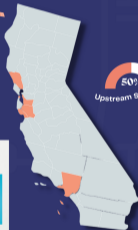

THE IMPORTANCE OF UPSTREAM SOLUTIONS...

Fifty percent of policies in the database are upstream solutions. Upstream policy solutions are those that reduce demand for tobacco products, mitigating upstream environmental impacts from growing, curing, manufacturing, and transporting tobacco products in addition to addressing post-consumer waste (litter). The Statewide Microplastics strategy states upstream source reduction is the most effective response to microplastic pollution. Examples of upstream TPW policies include:

- Banning the sale of single-use cigarette filters
- Banning the sale of single-use electronic cigarettes
- Comprehensive Tobacco Retail Licenses
- Tobacco Retailer Density Restrictions
